
# **Hamlet Cluster Association**

Paint & Siding Standards



## Warning:

Colors shown on this document are strictly for reference. Colors will be approximate on screen and likely inaccurate when printed! Do not use a printed version of this document for color matching. Use the Sherwin Williams palette for your phase for reference.

## **General Information**

The Hamlet Cluster is organized into Phase I and Phase 2 homes. Each phase is comprised of homes with very different styles and therefore we have approved color palettes and rules that best meet the design needs of each phase.

Homeowners must choose a paint scheme from the appropriate Hamlet phase based on their home's address. The approved paint colors are selected from modern Sherwin Williams colors. Homeowners may use paint from any manufacturer but are responsible for exactly matching the approved colors based on the appropriate Sherwin Williams palette for their phase.

Likewise, the siding product and colors are selected from modern Ply Gem Mastic vinyl siding options. All homes in the Hamlet must adhere to the siding standards including the 4" exposure and approved siding colors based on the Mastic Carvedwood • 44 collection. Siding from other manufacturers may be used but must match the appearance of the approved Carvewood • 44 collection.

#### **Phase 1 Color Rules & Options**

#### **Paint Colors**

Sherwin Williams America's Heritage Paint Palette

Phase I color schemes are required for homes on Stillbrook, Briary Branch and Dry River Courts

Tricorn Black may be used in place of the door/shutter color of any scheme.

Roycroft Vellum may be used in place of the door/shutter color for any scheme.

Storm doors must match the front door color or may be Tricorn Black.

Downspouts and gutters must be white or match the trim color.

Paint from other manufacturers must match the approved palette exactly.

#### **Phase 2 Color Rules & Options**

#### **Paint Colors**

#### **Sherwin Williams Suburban Traditional Palette**

Homeowners must choose from one of the Phase 2 color schemes.

Tricorn Black may be used in place of the door/shutter color for any scheme.

Roycroft Vellum may be used in place of the door/shutter color for any scheme.

Storm doors must match the front door color or may be Tricorn Black.

Downspouts and gutters must be white or match the trim color.

Homes with all-brick fronts may paint the door & trim the same color using one of the Phase 2 color scheme choices. The door/trim color must coordinate with the appropriate siding color for that scheme.

Paint from other manufacturers must match the approved palette exactly.
